## Patient Financial Responsibilities

- > The patient (or patient's guardian, if a minor) is ultimately responsible for the payment of provided care and treatment.
- > We will bill your medical insurance, or third party vision program benefit for you. However, the patient is required to provide the most correct and updated information regarding insurance.
- > Patients are responsible for payment of co-pay, coinsurance, deductibles, and all other procedure or treatment not covered by their insurance plan.
- > Co-pays are due at time of service.
- Medicare does not consider the refraction as a covered benefit. The refraction charge is \$25 and must be paid by the patient. The refraction is the part of the exam in which the doctor determines your need for prescription glasses using numerous optical lenses.
- > Patient may incur, and are responsible for payment of additional charges, if applicable. These charges may include: Charge for return checks- \$25.00
